

Penang Graveyard, Malaysia

This graveyard was founded in the late 1700s to serve the expatriate community. The following four Irish memorials were found; the first two are definitely Irish and the second two possibly based on the surnames. There may be others whose surnames are found across the UK with no other identifier. The Pengelly memorial is geographically confusing.
